As FarmHouse men, we are called to render service both in our home communities, and to societies across the world. The Journey - FarmHouse is an exciting opportunity for FarmHouse men to live our values and give back in the summer of 2016. Through a partnership with the Association of Fraternal Leadership and Values and Heart to Honduras, 15 or more FarmHouse men will travel to a village in Honduras for a week of service, learning and exploration of our shared values. **Program Dates: June 4 - 11, 2016**

The Experience

In a small community outside of San Pedro Sula, Honduras, FarmHouse will be hosted by local mission organization Heart to Honduras (H2H) that has been working in Honduras since 1989. Participants will work alongside and be able to connect with local community members while on-site and through intentional community excursions.

During the program, FarmHouse men will assist a local community in building a house for a family in need. In just a few short days, we'll turn a bare lot into a home that will have a life-changing impact on real people. Along the way, you'll learn about yourself, your community, your Fraternity and humanity. You'll also have a blast exploring a new culture with your brothers from around the nation.

What The Journey Is NOT & What The Journey Can Be



- *The Journey is NOT a vacation:* If you are looking to explore the city, sight-see, or take part in an international FarmHouse social, this might not be the experience for you. **Our time will be spent serving and connecting to the community, learning from each other, and exploring how to do things that matter.** Related, you should expect basic accommodations, you should expect that you will need to clean-up after yourself, and you should be prepared for cooking meals as a group.

- *The Journey is NOT a chapter training program:* Intentionally we have not created space for sessions or conversations on topics like recruitment, new member education, or officer transition. This program is not intended to make you the best chapter officer, **it is intended to challenge you to think about how you can use your FarmHouse experience to make the world a better place.**

- *What CAN The Journey Be?* In a few words from former participants: challenging, introspective, inspirational, adventurous, educational, impactful, eye-opening, and incredibly fun... and **if you're all in, it can truly be life-changing.**

Cost

The cost to attend The Journey: FarmHouse is \$1,600 which covers all airfare, lodging, ground transportation, meals, building supplies, translators, an excursion to a tourist attraction in Honduras and insurance. Beyond the participation fee, you will also be responsible for meals on travel days and for any spending money you wish to bring.

Please do not let cost deter you from participating. Participants can secure funding through a variety of sources, and are eligible to apply for the FarmHouse Foundation's Linville International Catalyst Scholarship, which can provide up to \$2,000 toward international educational experiences for FarmHouse men. **The Fraternity is committed to finding a way for all interested FarmHouse men to participate in The Journey, regardless of finances.**
