Scholarships & Requirements

❑ DARL & FLORENCE SNYDER NEW HORIZONS SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of the Darl & Florence Snyder New Horizons Scholarship is to broaden the horizons, exposure and experience of FarmHouse undergraduates through study abroad programs and international student travel opportunities. Through the generosity of the late Darl (IA 42) & Florence Snyder, a **\$600** scholarship will be awarded to two members of FarmHouse Fraternity participating in a university sponsored study abroad opportunity during the 2021-22 academic year. The intent of the scholarship is to support the expenses associated with study abroad. The recipients must be an initiated member of FarmHouse Fraternity, enrolled at a university hosting a FarmHouse Chapter and carry a schedule typical for their classification. The recipients must have a grade point average above or equal to the chapter's average and shall maintain satisfactory behavior.

❑ MILTON & PAULINE JELLUM STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP

Through the generosity of Milton (MN 53) and Pauline Jellum, an **\$850** scholarship will be awarded to two member of FarmHouse Fraternity for international study experience. Expenses can include, but are not restricted to, a) travel expenses to and from a foreign country related to an international student travel experience or study abroad; b) tuition and fees connected with being enrolled and admitted to study at an accredited college or university in a country outside of the United States and Canada; and/or c) room and board while studying in a foreign country. Recipients must be initiated members of FarmHouse Fraternity, enrolled at a university hosting a FarmHouse chapter and carrying a schedule typical for their classification. Recipients must have a grade point average above or equal to the International Fraternity's average, and shall maintain satisfactory behavior. First preference for the scholarship(s) shall be given to members of the Minnesota FarmHouse Chapter. Any remaining scholarship funds in a given fiscal year may be available as a scholarship to other qualified FarmHouse members.

❑ DR. OWEN J. NEWLIN MEMORIAL STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP

In honor of Dr. Owen J. Newlin's (IA 50) 70-year membership, long-time involvement and generosity, his FarmHouse brothers have established this memorial endowment fund, which will award a **\$1,000** scholarship to one member of FarmHouse Fraternity. The purpose of the scholarship is to broaden horizons, exposure and experience through international student travel opportunities and study abroad programs. Expenses can include, but are not restricted to, a) travel expenses to and from a foreign country related to an international student travel experience or study abroad; b) tuition and fees connected with being enrolled and admitted to study at an accredited college or university in a country outside of the United States and Canada; and/or c) room and board while studying in a foreign country. Recipients must be initiated members of FarmHouse and carrying a schedule typical for their classification. Recipients must have an accumulative GPA of 3.0 or above and shall maintain satisfactory behavior. First preference will be given to undergraduate members of the Iowa State FH Chapter.

Scholarship applications must be sent to the FarmHouse Foundation bearing a postmark no later than **June 1, 2021**. Selection of the recipient will be made by a committee appointed by the FarmHouse Foundation Trustees.
