

LLS Leadership Fund Advocacy Grant Application

The FarmHouse Foundation Leukemia-Lymphoma Society (LLS) Leadership Fund was established by Randy Linville (KS '73) to benefit FarmHouse chapters' efforts in support of LLS and "Be the Match" National Bone Marrow Registry. The fund, a first of its kind with the Foundation, provides grants to FarmHouse chapters for expenses related to hosting advocacy, philanthropic and/or service events in support of the missions for LLS and/or Be the Match to advance FarmHouse International Fraternity's national philanthropies.

Randy, a bone marrow donor himself and former Foundation Chairman, made this gift to not only support the Fraternity's national philanthropies, but also to provide unique leadership opportunities to teach members how to be advocates, leaders, educators and marketers in support of LLS and/or Be the Match to their peers and the community.

Receipt(s) of expenses must be attached to the application and will be reimbursed after the event occurs. Reimbursement shall be up to and not exceed \$500 per event, per chapter, per academic year. Expenses eligible for reimbursement may include event supplies, promotional and marketing materials, food and beverages, facility rental fees and event permits. The Foundation's reimbursement will be contingent based on the application submitted articulating the impact, implementation and advocacy efforts to promote LLS and/or be the Match.

Please attach relevant flyers, invitations, press releases, photos and other promotional materials used to publicize and implement the event. The FarmHouse Foundation is unable to release any monies without documentation for our records and receipts to reimburse from.
