MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN



What a year! Our Fraternity membership grew to nearly 1,700 undergraduate members, and we received gifts from 2,132 donors totaling over \$6.2 million, providing a real vote of confidence in the leadership development underway at FarmHouse. Here are some of the last fiscal year's highlights:

 Live. Learn. Lead. — The Campaign for FarmHouse pledges and contributions reached \$15.9 million,

well on the way to reaching our \$20 million goal.

- The third year of our Chairman's Club, recognizing Annual Fund support at the \$700 level and above, grew to 90 members.
- Our newest recognition level, *The Order of the Crest*, for cumulative lifetime giving of \$250,000 or more, now has 12 members with room for more.

The Foundation made grants

- totaling over \$696,000 to fund leadership training, the educational portion of chapter housing, scholarships, computer labs, program services and general Fraternity support. Additionally, over \$4.7 million will be saved for future grants for chapter housing projects at 16 chapters.
- Our endowment funds earned a return of 6.62 percent, even in a low interest rate environment.
- We spent 4.7 cents on fundraising for each dollar raised, an impressive and award-winning

- accomplishment by our talented Foundation team.
- Our asset base grew over 47 percent to \$17.2 million with the help of a number of chapter building campaigns and the strong results of *Live. Learn. Lead.* The Campaign for FarmHouse.
- The Chapter Housing Loan Program made its first two loans to the South Dakota State and North Dakota State FarmHouse Associations. We expect this program to help many more chapters and allow us to invest our fixed funds in a way that adds value at the chapter level. Thanks to our loan

committee for terrific leadership in this area.

I want to thank my fellow Trustees for their dedication, creativity and generous sharing of time, talent and treasure to help guide our endeavors.

We are also blessed to have a terrific staff, led by Allison Rickels, who work as a team to make all of this possible.

Finally and most importantly, thanks to each of you for your support and investment in the

future of FarmHouse and all our outstanding members.

This year's Annual Report comes to you on the heels of an exciting year for FarmHouse.

More undergraduates are joining FarmHouse each year, with more than 1,650 undergraduates currently. And, the Fraternity is expanding to more universities across North America—in the last five years, five new chapters have been chartered.

Additionally, the suite of leadership programs offered by the Fraternity is increasing in size and quality. In 2014, the International Fraternity added *The Journey: FarmHouse* service immersion experience to Honduras, *FarmHouse*

GROWS recruitment school and the Volunteer Leadership Summit for FarmHouse alumni volunteers who work with the chapters.

The Foundation is also experiencing unprecedented momentum following the launch of *Live. Learn. Lead. – The Campaign for FarmHouse.*

We are proud to announce that your generosity broke records again for fiscal year 2014-15, concluding Feb. 28, 2015.

You and **2,132** alumni, undergraduates and friends donated a record **\$6.23 million** to the Foundation, and our assets increased to over **\$17.2 million**.

In turn, \$696,248 was granted for leadership training, computer technology, academic scholarships, the educational portion of chapter housing and support of the International Office.

Additionally, over **\$4.7 million** of what was raised will be saved for future grants for the educational portion of chapter housing projects at 16 chapters.

All that being said, it isn't about the money.

It is about making FarmHouse's mission possible with the support you give year after year. It is about you extending your generosity and investing in 1,650 young men you may have never met.

WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO

The FarmHouse Foundation (Tax ID #36-6111880) is a duly organized public foundation which is exempt from federal income taxes and which may accept tax deductible gifts under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Foundation, through its Board of Trustees and Staff, organizes and administers various funding solicitations of FarmHouse members and friends of the Fraternity, and manages and administers the property and finances of the Foundation for the benefit of the student members of the Fraternity.



Foundation Launches \$20 Million Campaign

"We envision FarmHouse as a premier leadership organization. One that attracts the best and brightest men, supports their education in and out of the classroom, provides them a support system with a safe, comfortable and affordable home to live in, and continues to be a Builder of Men for generations to come."

This bold vision was announced at the 48th Biennial Conclave on July 26, 2014. The FarmHouse Foundation Trustees joined with undergraduates, alumni, staff and friends to launch *Live. Learn. Lead.*—

The Campaign for FarmHouse.

This Campaign is the most ambitious fundraising effort in the Fraternity and Foundation's history with a goal to raise \$20 million.

Thanks to the generosity of a growing list of leaders and exemplars, the Foundation kicked off the public phase of the Campaign with the announcement that \$12.1 million, more than half of the goal, had been raised.

As of June 30, an impressive \$17 million has been invested in the Campaign. FarmHouse alumni have shown that they are ready, locally and Internationally, to support their Fraternity in significant ways.

The Foundation's goal is to raise the remainder of its goal by Conclave 2016— a challenging task, to be sure, but one the Foundation Trustees and Staff are confident can be accomplished with the help of every FarmHouse man.

The most effective investments are unrestricted for use where the challenges and outcomes are the greatest.

<u>Legacy Endowment Funds</u> \$7 million goal

An investment in one of our 146 endowment funds, or establishing a named

endowment fund, permanently ensures FarmHouse will always have the "seed corn" necessary for the future.

Chapter Excellence Funds \$10 million goal

Additionally, donors can support their chapter's educational programs and local chapter housing campaigns through their Building Fund or Foundation Council.

"Live. Learn. Lead. — The Campaign for FarmHouse is about taking the next step, realizing our potential and changing the lives of hundreds of FarmHouse young men not just today, but forever," said Allison Rickels, Foundation executive director in announcing the Campaign.

She continued, "FarmHouse is stronger than ever. But, if progress shall mark our every step, it's time to think and invest even bigger than before.

This Campaign allows us to honor all that FarmHouse has achieved, and by reaching our \$20 million goal, assures we can continue to support the next generation of exceptional FarmHouse men in unprecedented ways."

DONORS GIVE OVER \$61,000 DURING 48TH CONCLAVE

Arms were flying, spotters were calling and the auctioneer was rushing to keep up with bids during the Foundation's Conclave Benefit Auction on July 26, 2014. Bidders competed for items ranging from Indy 500 box seat tickets, and a private plane ride along the Lake Michigan shoreline to a custommade metal FarmHouse crest and Monsanto sweet corn seed.

Attendees and FarmHouse alumni across the country also had the opportunity to bid on items throughout the week during the online silent auction.

We thank all of our Auction donors

and those who contributed unique items, exclusive experiences and FH memorabilia to make the Auction a success.

Proceeds from the Live & Silent Auction, totaling \$16,604 provided educational grants to FarmHouse International Fraternity for the leadership speakers and educational programming presented during Conclave. This money will also help the Fraternity secure nationally-acclaimed leadership speakers and plan top-notch educational programs for the 49th Biennial Conclave in 2016.

Also, as part of the Live Auction,

donors contributed an additional \$39,196 to the Annual Fund during the special "Fund-The-Need" auction.

In addition to the live and silent auctions, the Foundation's "Stars of FarmHouse" wall was back again. A record-breaking 588 stars shone on the wall, raising over \$5,900 for the Annual Fund. Alumni and friends of FarmHouse had the opportunity to purchase a star in honor or memory of a brother even if they couldn't attend Conclave.

Altogether, over \$61,000 was raised during Conclave for Foundation grants.

13 GENEROUS ALUMNI JOIN NEW GIVING SOCIETY

At the 48th Biennial Conclave, the FarmHouse Foundation Trustees launched *Live. Learn. Lead.—The Campaign for FarmHouse.* This is the most ambitious fundraising effort in the Fraternity and Foundation's history with a goal to raise \$20 million.

In conjunction with the kickoff, Foundation Chairman Jim Tobin (IA '76) announced the Foundation's newest giving society, *The Order of the Crest*. PHILANTHROPY LAUREATES

The Philanthropy Laureate Award was established in 1999 by the FarmHouse Foundation Board of Trustees. This distinguished designation for outstanding philanthropic support is the highest honor bestowed by the Foundation. The recipient(s) must have exhibited great philanthropic intent throughout his/her life, be a member of the Fraternity, or have some connection with a FarmHouse brother, spouse, parent, relative, etc. Often the recipient is an individual who has made financial and service contributions of significant dimension to the Foundation, individual FarmHouse chapters and/or society. Recipients may be chosen annually, but are recognized at the Fraternity's biennial Conclave. Since its inception, 16 men have been named Philanthropy Laureates.



Kent Horsager

Kent Horsager (MN '81) is past Chairman (2003-2005) and former Trustee (1999-2005) of the Foundation's Board of Trustees, providing outstanding leadership during his tenure.

Kent helped develop the Foundation's strategic plan, assisted with the executive search efforts and transition between executive directors Bob Off and Allison Rickels, and helped successfully lead the Foundation through their first-ever capital campaign,

Campaign 2005, for FarmHouse's 100th Anniversary.

Today, Kent is helping to lead Minnesota Chapter's Housing Campaign, including being a significant donor to their building project. He also serves as a judge for the Foundation's international immersion scholarship committee. Kent is a member of the Century Club, for accumulative gifts of \$100,000 and more.

Professionally, Kent is President & CEO of Compass Strategic Investments, a firm that specializes in creating and operating managed futures programs for individuals and institutional clients. Kent has been involved in globally trading futures and options markets since 1984, after he graduated from the University of Minnesota. Kent also served a number of years as Chairman, President and CEO of the Minneapolis Grain Exchange.

As a volunteer, Kent is past president of the University of Minnesota Alumni Association, and on the board of directors for the National Futures Association, the National Grain Trade Council, his church council as well as other industry related boards and non-profit organizations.

Kent and his wife, Beth, live in St. Anthony, Minn. They have three grown children, Aaron, Janet and Phillip. Phillip (MN '12) is a junior and member of the Minnesota FarmHouse Chapter.



Ryan Downs

Ryan Downs (NE '88) is past Chairman (2010-12) and former Trustee (2005-12) of the Foundation's Board of Trustees, providing tremendous leadership and serving an additional year on the Board.

Ryan led the development and direction of the Foundation's current strategic plan, managed the creation of the Chapter Housing Loan Program and set the long-term course for their current fundraising initiatives. During

his tenure as Chairman, the Foundation realized back-to-back record years in fundraising.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER LEAVES A LEGACY

I've always admired the wisdom of the Fraternity's practice and policy of allowing the chapters to initiate worthy men as associate members that didn't become members as undergraduates for whatever reason. Many, if not most, have become exemplary members, generously giving of their "time, pleasures and comforts" as chapter advisors, serving on association boards and on the International Executive Board.

One such man was John Riley (KS '73). John passed away suddenly on Sept. 16, 2013, at the age of 66. He was professor of agricultural economics at the University of Tennessee (UT), working there since 1995, and serving four years as the dean of agriculture. He became an advisor for the Tennessee Chapter shortly after coming to UT from Kansas State University, where he had been professor of ag economics and assistant director of resident instruction for the Ag College.

It was at Kansas State that John became involved with FarmHouse, and the chapter initiated him as an associate member. He served a number of years as an advisor to the K-State Chapter and as mentor to many chapter members for over 20 years.

In 2011, John shared his estate plans with Allison Rickels, the FarmHouse Foundation's executive director, and he became the second member to join the Foundation's **100** Legacies In The Making Campaign.

In early June of 2014, John's estate was settled, and his bequest to the Foundation of close to a half million dollars became the largest estate gift the Foundation had received at the time. The major beneficiary was the Tennessee Chapter's Building Fund, which has the potential to be a game changer for that chapter. The K-State Chapter's building fund also received a generous amount, as did the Annual Fund.

We celebrate John's devotion and service to the Fraternity, and we are grateful for his generosity. John's example as an associate member is a reminder of the role FarmHouse has played in shaping and building each of us. Further, it underscores the opportunity that alumni and friends of the Fraternity have, through the 100 Legacies In The Making Campaign, to assure that the Fraternity continues to Build Men in perpetuity.

Our goal is for 100 alumni to step up and make provision for a bequest or other planned gift of \$10,000 or more, which the donor has not previously advised the Foundation Trustees about. Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) is the Foundation's threshold for named endowment funds that become a permanent part of the Foundation's support for the Fraternity.

To date, 53 alumni have pledged over \$3.6 million in estate gifts through the *100 Legacies in the Making Campaign*, and we are working on more.

We haven't reached our goal—yet! To do so, we ask you to consider John Riley's example and how you might leave a legacy with FarmHouse. Many of us don't have the opportunities that John had to directly advise and mentor our undergraduate brothers, but we can use our estate to support the Building of Men.

Their executive director, Allison Rickels, is the first woman to lead the foundation of an all-male fraternity."



PROGRAMS & GRANTS

Thanks to you and other generous FarmHouse alumni and friends from across North America, the FarmHouse Foundation was able to provide the Fraternity \$696,248 in funding for educational and leadership purposes in the 2014-15 fiscal year.



LEADERSHIP TRAINING & EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

\$141,481 was provided for leadership training and educational programs. Nearly 600 chapter members were directly impacted and all 1,650 members were indirectly affected. Below is a list of FarmHouse educational and leadership programs for FY 14-15.

FarmHouse Leadership Institute (FLI)

The FarmHouse Leadership Institute (FLI) is held each January in Kansas City, Mo., and gathers top undergraduate leaders from across North America for four intense days of leadership training. Read more on pages 31-32.

Regional Leadership Conferences (RLC)

The 2015 RLCs were held in Mobile, Ala.; Billings, Mont.; and Detroit, Mich. The curriculum featured the leadership book, "An Enemy called Average," which focused on understanding and identifying ways to improve chapters. Members attended workshops on leadership, career networking, professional etiquette and financial education. Each RLC also featured a night out in the host city—the USS Alabama, a WWII-era battleship anchored in Mobile Bay, Ala.; the Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument at Custer's Last Stand and the Lakota Indian Tribe Memorial, in Crow Agency, Mont.; and the Henry Ford Museum, in Dearborn, Mich.

To Be and Become... Emerging Talent Retreat

Each chapter is invited to send a man who has completed his first year of college to the To Be & Become... Emerging Talent Retreat. Last fiscal year, 28 men attended the conference held May 21-23, 2014, at Camp Heartland outside of Kansas City, Mo. The curriculum included individual leadership development through the *StrengthsQuest* program, outdoor adventure team building activities and a high ropes course.

2014 Conclave

The 48th Biennial Conclave was held in Charlotte, N.C., July 23-27, 2014. This biennial meeting of FarmHouse representatives from every chapter and association included educational programming workshops, Conclave committee and delegate meetings and the election of International Executive Board leadership. Master Builders and Philanthropy Laureates were recognized and attendees enjoyed activities in the Charlotte area. During Conclave donors gave over \$61,000 to support the educational programs and initiatives of FarmHouse International Fraternity and Foundation.

Power of 7 Seminar

This award-winning Seminar is a first-class think-tank on the nation and FarmHouse Fraternity. The program is an informal forum, conducted under the leadership of the Foundation Trustees, on the international business climate and economy. Membership in The Power of 7 is exclusive to alumni who pledge to give \$7,000, a tax-deductible gift, to the Annual Fund. In return, they are invited to attend a dynamic, interactive two-day educational Seminar and mentor a top junior or senior undergraduate leader. Read more on page 28.

Inaugural The Journey: FarmHouse

May 31-June 6, 2014, 14 FarmHouse men and facilitators traveled to Honduras to offer "service to their fellowmen and to the world." They built a house for a family in need, toured the countryside and learned about

Honduran agriculture. In addition to the service and immersion components, dedicated time was spent in group discussion and personal reflection related to their work, the community they were working in and how they could continue to make a difference in their home communities

Support for Individual Chapters

Through the chapters' Foundation Councils, the Foundation provides support for local chapter programming such as chapter retreats, etiquette dinners and leadership training seminars on both the local campus and national level.

Fraternity's Chapter Consultation Program

Fraternity Educational Leadership Consultants visit each chapter and colony every year. They live in the chapter house for several days, meet with chapter officers and offer leadership programming to all chapter members. They then make recommendations for improvement and provide support following the visit.

Association & Advisor Visit Education Program

Trained staff and volunteers travel to chapters to assess and monitor the effectiveness of the chapter advisory team leadership. They work to connect alumni volunteers with local chapters and associations through volunteer service and assist in training and educating advisors and association board members on topics and issues relevant to chapters and undergraduate students.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

One of the most visible acts of the FarmHouse Foundation is to offer brothers an opportunity to receive financial aid. Each year the Foundation offers scholarships that are open to all FarmHouse undergraduates. Last year, 12 undergraduate members were awarded \$14,975 in unrestricted scholarships from the Foundation. Other scholarships that the Foundation administers, totaling \$42,752, were awarded to members of specific chapters as designated by donors. The recipients of these scholarships were selected locally. In total, the Foundation awarded \$57,727 to 77 individual members last fiscal year. EDUCATIONAL PORTIONS OF CHAPTER HOUSING

\$327,454 supported educational portions of chapter house construction and renovations on eight campuses. Currently, 16 chapters and associations are raising funds with the Foundation for new construction or renovations of their chapter houses. Over \$4.7 million was raised last year and will be saved for grants for this purpose.

COMPUTERS & AFFILIATED TECHNOLOGY

\$10,743 granted to five chapters and associations for in-house computers and technology, affecting nearly all chapter members directly.

RE-CONTRIBUTION TO CHAPTERS

\$3,984 distributed to chapters' foundation councils for their specific educational uses and needs through the Annual Fund's re-contribution program.

PROGRAM SERVICES

\$65,789 for the Foundation staff to administer the educational grants in support of the International Fraternity, chapters and associations.

FRATERNITY SUPPORT

\$44,327 paid to the International Fraternity to support operations of the International Office, membership database, online communications and *Pearls & Rubies*.

YEUTTER SCHOLARSHIP HONORS FORMER U.S. SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE

Several of Dr. Clayton Yeutter's (NE '49) friends and FarmHouse brothers, led by long-time friends Ben and Marsha Neff, decided it was long overdue to

honor Yeutter's worldwide contributions to agriculture and public service.

Knowing his long-time affiliation with FarmHouse International Fraternity and his support of higher education, it was determined that a scholarship fund in Clayton's name was most appropriate.

Led by the Neff's generosity, The Clayton K. Yeutter Scholarship Fund, honoring his service as United States Secretary of Agriculture, 1989 to 1991 was established.

The purpose of the endowed fund is to annually provide academic scholarships to recognize and reward outstanding student members of FarmHouse who are seeking degrees in agriculture and/or public affairs.

With over a half century of public service, it is difficult to recount all of Yeutter's esteemed activities.

A native Nebraskan, Clayton served in various leadership roles at the University of Nebraska and in state government prior to serving four United States presidents as Assistant Secretary of Agriculture, U.S. Secretary of Agriculture, U.S. Trade Representative and U.S. Ambassador for Special Trade.

As a Master Builder, Yeutter's service has not been confined to the public sector, he played a key role in a number of private enterprises as well. He served seven years as president of the Chicago Mercantile Exchange, served on the board of directors of 22 for-profit corporations, including some of the nation's largest. He helped make a difference through his role as a member of the board of directors of numerous non-profit organizations in the United States and internationally.

Although Clayton has been awarded eight honorary doctorate degrees and numerous citations and plaques, his friends felt a scholarship fund for college students would encourage future leadership in agriculture and/or public affairs. A reflection of the life Dr. Yeutter continues to live.

In learning of the scholarship, Clayton said, "This scholarship means more to me than all the trophies and awards I have accumulated over a lifetime. It really hits home to what life, and friends, and colleagues are all about. They're worth more than all of the material things with which we have been blessed." "It was during those four years at FarmHouse that I grew up," he added. "I discovered that I would have to earn everything I got, and that I was expected to toe the line of FarmHouse principles. None of my career experiences would ever have occurred had I not spent those four wonderful years at FarmHouse."

"We are grateful to those friends and FH brothers of Clayton's who have so generously given to create a scholarship in Clayton's name," said Allison Rickels, Foundation executive director.

"This fund will permanently honor Clayton's prominent and esteemed career in public service, the incredible impact he has made on countless individuals, communities and businesses across our country, and his lifelong involvement and pride in being a FarmHouse member. This annual scholarship will impact the education of numerous budding civic leaders to help them become the next generation of leaders of our country, like Clayton."

Since the creation of the scholarship in Clayton's name, additional FarmHouse brothers and colleagues have contributed in his honor. Additional gifts to this scholarship fund are continually welcomed and accepted. A list of donors will be kept and shared with Clayton from time to time.

When the C.J. and Dorothy Gauger Endowment was initially established by four of C.J.'s mentees, it was decided the best way to honor C.J. was to support the newest members of the Fraternity.

This was because, as C.J. told it, he thought he "wasn't cut out for college and didn't think he could afford being in a fraternity," until he was introduced to FarmHouse.

As a Master Builder, C.J. was a life-long teacher, servant leader and mentor to thousands of young people. So, it was fitting for this fund to support the To Be and Become...Emerging Talent Retreat for new members across the Fraternity. To Be and Become is an award-winning outdoor experiential learning retreat designed as a leadership assessment and personal strengths development opportunity.

In anticipation of his centennial birthday in March 2014, the Foundation

assisted four Iowa State alumni, who had previously established an endowment fund to recognize C.J., with a plan to recognize him.

Together with the staff, they led a short-term, intensive fundraising campaign to honor C.J. and his many years of service to the Fraternity and young men across the nation. The campaign was launched on January 5, 2014, exactly 100 days prior to Founders' Day on April 15.

Thanks to 115 FarmHouse brothers and friends, the "100 days for \$100,000 by 100 years" campaign was a tremendous success. Remarkably, in only 100 days, \$85,000 was raised to grow the endowment to \$100,000.

Thanks to the generosity of the donors, the Gauger Endowment Fund will provide permanent funding and support for the To Be and Become... Emerging Talent Retreat.

At C.J.'s FarmHouse 100th birthday party on March 2, 2014, and again at the Iowa State FH Founders' Day Celebration on April 12, 2014, the news was shared with C.J. and those gathered for the special occasion.

In response to this news, C.J. said, "FarmHouse has opened many doors for me and I have tried to reciprocate by opening doors for brothers and others.

I am so humbled, but pleased that these gifts will continue to support FarmHouse and young people as they strive to improve and grow." C.J. was always a "builder of men" with his commitment to young people as a vocational agriculture educator, an extension agent, state 4-H leader and counsel to FarmHouse chapters and alumni members alike. His extensive involvement in FarmHouse was recognized by his peers by being named a Master Builder of Men in 1984.


This campaign not only honored C.J., but also enabled future generations of Farmhouse new members to experience this award-winning, once-in-a-lifetime Retreat for years to come.





Your Support

Electronic Transfer Gift Program

This program allows you to have money withdrawn directly from your checking or saving account without having to write monthly checks or make one substantial gift. Gifts can be withdrawn either monthly or quarterly, on either the 1st or 15th of the month.

Gifts of Grain

The Foundation can accept gifts of grain. When making such a gift you will receive a tax deduction, or if you don't itemize, it will reduce the income you have to pay taxes on. For more information about making a gift of grain, please contact the Foundation.

Memorial and Honorary Gifts

Stock Gifts

Appreciated Stocks and mutual funds can be transferred electronically from your brokerage account or can be sent through the mail if held in certificate form.



Matching Gifts

Endowment & Named Funds

Permanently endowed funds may be established and named in accordance with a donor's wishes through gifts of \$10,000 or more. Endowments may also be created with smaller gifts that the donor pledges to increase, over five years,

to the \$10,000 level. Endowment funds provide a constant source of income for the Foundation and are spent with careful consideration of the donor's intentions. Choosing to endow and name a Fraternity program or scholarship is a terrific way to Permanently establish and recognize your legacy in FarmHouse.

Planned Gifts
